

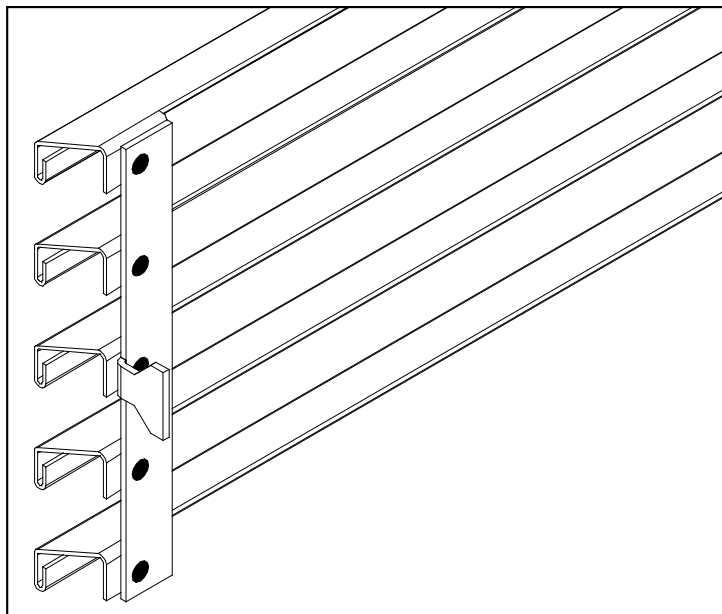
Louver Kit

Kit Contents:

Please ensure that you have two (2) louvers in this kit. If the louvers have been damaged, contact your dealer, distributor, or courier company before starting this installation.

Installation of Kit:

1. Remove the new plated louvers from the packaging and inspect them.
2. Remove the old louver set from the appliance and lay the set face down on a soft surface.
3. Using a standard screwdriver or ¼" socket remove the screws from each end, at the brackets, of the old painted louvers that you choose to replace with the new plated louvers. See figure below.
4. Switch the old painted louvers from the set with the new plated louvers. The hook on the end brackets must be facing outward and the bottom of the louvers are open.
5. Reinstall the screws on both ends of all the replaced louvers. Do not over tighten.
6. Install the modified louver set onto the appliance.



CLEANING THE SURFACES:

Painted faces should be wiped with a damp cloth periodically. If a plated face has been purchased, it should be unpacked/unwrapped carefully to avoid getting anything on the surface of the finish, including cleaners, polish and finger prints. It is important to note that fingerprints and other marks can leave a permanent stain on plated finishes. To avoid this, give the face a quick wipe with denatured alcohol on a soft cloth BEFORE lighting the fireplace. Never clean the face when it is hot. Do not use other cleaners as they may leave a residue, which can become permanently etched into the surface.

If your fingers come into contact with the antique copper finish, the oils left as fingerprints on the copper can cause discoloration, which will eventually turn green in that area. You can clean the patina or discolored areas of the antique copper finish with "OO" 3M green sanding pads. These can be purchased from most hardware stores. On the areas with discoloration, use the sanding pads to sand in the same direction as the brushed finish, then blend the finish by feathering in the surrounding area. This refinishing procedure has been approved by the manufacturer and will not harm the finish. Please note: ANTIQUE COPPER IS THE ONLY FINISH THAT CAN BE SANDED, DO NOT SAND PEWTER, GOLD OR NICKEL FINISHES.
